ANNUAL REPORT OF THE DIOCESAN BOARD OF DOMESTIC AND FOREIGN MISSIONS.

To the LORD BISHOP OF FREDERICTON, and MEMBERS OF THE DIOCESAN SYNOD.

In submitting a report of the work done by the Diocese for Domestic and Foreign Missions during the past year, your Board record with thankfulness an increase in contributions over those of several previous years.

The amounts received by the Treasurer for Domestic Missions are as follows: Diocese of Algoma, \$269.86; Bishop of Algoma's Stipend, \$15;¹ Homes for Indian Children in Algoma and the North-West, \$421.01; Domestic Missions (unappropriated), \$375.35; North-West Missions, \$49.59; Diocese of Qu'Appelle, \$7.50—making a total of \$1,138.31, an increase of \$186.02 over the amount raised last year.

For Foreign Missions the contributions were: For the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel in Foreign Parts, \$404.57; for the Society for Promoting Christianity among the Jews, \$73.88; for Parochial Missions to Jews, \$101.06; for Bishop Blyth's Work, \$86.77; for Mission in Japan under the Rev. Cooper Robinson, \$53.87; and for Church Missionary Society, \$2—making a total of \$722.15, a small increase over last year.

In addition to the above amounts, we are duly informed that \$40 have been forwarded by the Rev. J. M. Davenport from his congregation to "Benson's East Indian Missions," and that \$75 for the Shingwauk Home, \$52.77 for the Church Missionary Society, and \$65.89 for the Society for Promoting Christianity among the Jews have been forwarded from St. John's Church in this city; also \$150 from Trinity Church for support of Indian children in Algoma, making a grand total of \$2,244.12 as the amount raised in the Diocese for Domestic and Foreign Missions during the past year.

The amount of \$300 from the Diocese for the Bishop of Algoma's Stipend has been regularly remitted. As, however, only \$15 were paid in for that special object, your Board had to appropriate a sufficient sum for that purpose from moneys received for the Diocese of Algoma and Domestic Missions, in accordance with the authority given it by the Synod.

As heretofore, the Board of Management of the Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society issued Appeals at Epiphany and Ascensiontide, to be read by request of the Bishops of this Ecclesiastical Province to all
