

THE TENTH ANNUAL REPORT OF THE BIBLE CHRISTIAN MISSIONARY SOCIETY.

The Society occupies seventeen stations in Canada West; six in Prince Edward Island; and six in the United States of America: on which there are laboring 38 Missionaries, assisted by 122 Local Preachers. Upon these Missions there are 86 Chapels and 103 other preaching stations; 3,153 persons in church fellowship; 3,015 Sabbath School children, taught by 487 teachers.

The affairs of the Society are managed by a Committee appointed annually by the Conference.
