Catherine Kaimisau, an Indian woman,  
has occupied one tenement  
since 1<sup>st</sup> May '85. Paid in all \$39.00  
She still owes the sum of  
\$3.00 she is good pay.

J. C. Perras, blacksmith - obtained the  
permission in '84 to work  
of his trade on the reserve  
has occupied one tenement  
from 1<sup>st</sup> Jan '85 - to 1<sup>st</sup> May
