### SOCIAL SERVICE COUNCIL

The executive of the New Brunswick Social Service Council met in the board of trade rooms yesterday afternoon. The secretary, Rev. F. S. Dowling, was authorized to forward to the proper authorities the resolutions adopted at the recent congress of T. H. Estabrooks, W. S. Fisher and Archibald Fraser of Fredericton, were appointed a finance committee, and Hon. R. J. Ritchie, Miss Jean Cooper, Rev. W. D. Wilson, Rural Dean Sampson, the secretary and president were appointed a committee to prepare a constitution. The president was authorized to appoint a committee to watch proposed legislation affecting social welfare, and keep the council informed. A resolution was adopted to organize a Social Service Council for the city and county of St. John, and the view was expressed that such a local council should be formed in every county in the province at as early a time as may be practicable. There was a good attendance of local members of the executive, and from outside points were Mrs. Vanvar, Miss Jean Cooper, Rev. W. D. Wilson, and Rev. D. W. Roberts, of Fredericton, and Mrs. Herbert Reid of Andover.
