

NEW CANADIAN COMMISSION

Ottawa, Oct. 12.—(Special)—The government appointed on Saturday last a new commission whose duties it will be to take stock of Canadian natural resources and to investigate and report such problems as those of rail and water transportation and marketing, immigration, increased production, the placing of soldiers after the war, co-operative systems, farmers' credits, unemployment, etc. It is in short a general purpose commission which is called upon to solve nearly all the problems now before the government.
