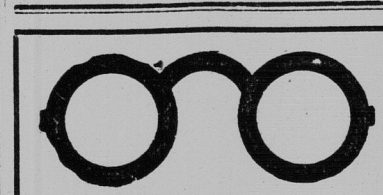

GETTING READY FOR WINTER

Paris, Sept. 30.—The Temps in the course of an article calling on the government to take proper measures to see that the soldiers do not have to undergo unnecessary hardships in the winter says: "The eventuality of a winter campaign ought not to be a surprise to anyone knowing the military power and resources of the enemy. Our tactics, which have consisted from the beginning in wearing down methodically until the hour strikes for a successful offensive imply operations of a certain duration." The Temps continues that the present military situation warrants the belief that the eventuality of a winter campaign will not develop in French territory, but in the regions between the Belgian Ardennes and the Rhine, where the last and first months of the year are particularly severe.

Despatches from Rotterdam say that the German military authorities are working day and night to obtain thick clothes for the eventuality of a winter campaign, which until recently had not been looked for by the Germans. They also are purchasing sleeping bags wherever they can be obtained for the soldiers to sleep in during the cold season.
