S. W. Jacobs Would Lock Subsidy Door and Throw Away Key

SHAUGHNESSY PLAN OF FUSION FAVORED

U. S. Quota Law Drawing Out Native Canadians Says Montreal M. P.

OTTAWA, April 23.—A further plea for amalgamation of the Canadian National and Canadian Pacific Railway systems was heard in the House today. There were echoes of Sir Henry Thornton's statement before the Railway Commission that such an amalgamation would result in enormous savings.

"My suggestion," declared S. W. Jacobs, Liberal, of Montreal, "is that the lines should be amalgamated so that we might never hear the word subsidy again; that we should close the door on it, lock the door and throw away the key." Mr. Jacobs favored the C. P. R. taking over the National lines under some scheme as that of Lord Slough.

SEES NO ROOM FOR 3 LINES. There was no room in Canada for three transcontinental lines, but for the Canadian National to take over the C. P. R. would be like taking a child which had never been sick and putting it to bed with a child suffering from contagious disease.

Mr. Jacobs complained that the effect of the United States quota law was to draw away from Canada her native Canadians with the result that Canada might soon be as bare of native Canadians as Jacques Cartier found it in 1534.

IMMIGRATION BLAMED. Immigration, Mr. Jacobs pressed, should be allowed to flow through natural channels. Like the wisdom of God, the government's immigration policy "passeth all understanding."
