Part of the deckload was washed off from the vessel struck Sunday afternoon the wind was on shore and the vessel rolled so heavily from side to side that the chain bolts were drawn, or the chain plates broke, and the masts being without the support of the rigging soon worked loose and finally broke off. The forecast broke close to the deck while about half of the masts, remains the upper part together with the topmast being carried away. About three quarters of the deck load was lost and the vessel is so badly damaged and broken up it is doubtful if it can be repaired. She is now lying at the wharf.
