MANITOBA ELECTIONS. FOLLOWING the lead given by the Ontario workers, Labor has made its mark in the Manitoba Provincial elections, having even gone a shade better in the number of representatives elected.

The contest for the ten seats in Winnipeg under the proportional representation system, was quite naturally the centre of general interest, and from the results the system on its trial trip, in Manitoba elections, has found a general consensus of opinion that it was a gratifying success, giving a correct reflex of the opinions of the electors, something which would have been unattainable under the old method of selection.

Reverting to the Ontario elections there was a difference in regard to the U.F.O. party who made no special effort in this election, deciding to reserve their strength for the next Federal election.

Insofar as the workers' success is concerned, it cannot be said that it was a surprise, as a city which sent a Federal representative some fifteen years ago, in the person of Arthur Puttee, was surely expected to show strength at this period of running tide.

Trade union ethics and constitutional method belong to the majority of the Labor candidates elected, and history may repeat itself with those whose advocacy is of the dreamy or unsatisfactory nature, that their entry in the school of legislation the difference between the attainable and impossible may become apparent.

The workers in provinces other than Manitoba extend full-hearted felicitations and congratulations to the workers of the prairie province. The Ontario section welcome the newcomer to direct representation. For a greater usefulness the trust has been placed in the hands of those selected by the workers and initiated movements to the common weal alone will make for that desirable permanency of the workers' party in Manitoba, who have no royal road to the maintenance of position attained, other than the power which comes from service given to the best interest of all the units comprising the community.


