exactly. I assured them, that
eighty acres would be given,
at the place, in question, to every
family who settled on the locality,
and that I would ascertain
the exact position of the Reserve,
and the extent of wood connected
with it. - With this, they ex-
pressed themselves satisfied,
and stated that the Sioux in the
Province would settle on their
Reserve. As the grasshoppers
were destroying their garden plants,
they asked for some means of
catching fish and game. I told
them, I would give them hooks
and lines, and a small quantity
of ammunition. The Young
chief, informed me, that he was
returning at once to the Reserve,
with eight of his men to erect
buildings and wanted a division
of the oven between himself and
White
