government and efficiency of the corps. Penalties were also enacted for negligent discharge of duty. The salaries of the officers and men were arranged by the Governor. The pay was very liberal, when we consider the purchasing power of money 50 years ago. The Commissioner's salary was arranged between \$2,000 and \$2,600 a year. Each Superintendent's salary ranged from \$1,000 to \$1,400 a year; each constable was paid \$1.00 a day, and every sub-constable 75 cents per day. The foregoing are the principal enactments under the Act of 1872.

Soll das Denkmal jedoch einigermaßen imposant werden und den Rahmen eines gewöhnlichen Grabsteines überragen, dann müssen die Gaben noch reichlicher fließen — und zwar schnell. Etliche Gemeinden haben noch gar nichts beigetragen, und etliche andere haben sich durch ihre Beiträge sicherlich nicht wehe getan. Soll das Denkmal im Juni eingeweiht werden, so ist es jetzt höchste Zeit, es bestellen. — Wer also noch in

dankbarer Liebe und treuer Anhänglichkeit an den guten Abt Bruno denkt, der sende für das ihm zu errichtende Denkmal innerhalb der nächsten zwei bis drei Wochen seine Gabe.
