Trading light transactions numbering about 300,000 Shares-Canadian Pacific weak - Monthly statement showed falling off of \$2,537 for May.


New York, June 5—Little or nothing remained today of the boom which yesterday sent stocks in general to the highest levels of recent weeks. The effect of the United States Steel decision seemed to have spent its force for a time, steel shares as well as the other leaders reflecting moderate pressure.

The light trading of today's short session—about 300,000 shares—consisted largely of an evening up of weekly accounts. Opening prices showed a number of declines, these being most fractional, but later Steel common and preferred, Canadian Pacific, Union Pacific and American Can receded a point each, Canadian Pacific becoming weaker as the session progressed.

Amalsamated Copper and Anaconda Copper were among the few features of strength, the former rising above its high prices of the previous day.

All the motor issues made considerable gains, presumably as a result of the enormous stock dividend 'declared by one of the better known companies. Advances in these stocks

KAISER'S "UNOFFICIAL SPOKESMAN" TO QUIT AMERICA FOR NORWAY



Reports are current that Dr. Bernhard Dernburg, whose mission to the United States was to create public opinion favorable to Germany, will leave within a few days, going to Norway. The so-called "unofficial spokesman of the Kalser" will leave on board a Norwegian steamship, it was said, and his passage without molestation by the war ships of the Allies is understood to have been assured. Nothing will be done to stop him. Dr. Dernburg has been speaking through the United States, giving the German side. His last speech was at Cleveland. Ohio.
