HOME RULE PROPOSALS.

Opinions of the English Press on Gladstone's Measures. A Loyal Union Meeting in London Protests against the Premier's Project.

Irish Corporations pass Resolutions Expressing Gratitude to Gladstone. Special to Gleaner. LONDON, April 10.—The Standard says if Lord Hartington is prepared to act on his own advice the fate of Gladstone's scheme is sealed already.

The Daily News this morning, commenting on the debate in parliament on Chamberlain's arguments, though not conclusive, deserve to be attentively considered. Chamberlain deals with superficial symptoms while Gladstone goes to the root of the disease.

The continental opinion on Gladstone's scheme is varied. Many staunch supporters of Gladstone are unable to approve of his measure. Gladstone has placed on the notice paper of the House of Commons notice that he will ask leave on Thursday to introduce a bill to make amended provision for sale and purchase of land in Ireland.

The Royal Patriotic Union held a meeting in London last night at which resolutions were adopted denouncing Gladstone's scheme. The Union has a meeting for Wednesday next to be held in Her Majesty's theatre to protest against the project of the premier.
