During the last few days the market has developed unusual activity, transactions being quite heavy, and today it was not far behind, although not quite so pronounced.

For this the important news of the last few days has been chiefly responsible. though the general bullish and optimistic feeling as to the future of the mines and

There were several of the unlisted stocks traded in today, amongst which were Finpress, 1000 shares of which sold at 19½, and King, 2500 of which sold at 2½.

Virtue sold to the amount of 2000 shares at 42½, and Montreal-London was traded in in broken lots at 48, 46 and 46½.

The demand for Rambler Cariboo is good, but there is no stock on the market.

The feeling in Golden Star was firmer with a better undertone, but no sales took place.

There were sales recorded in Republic at 122, and in Slocan Sovereign at 35½.

The following statement has been forward ed to the shareholders of the Bullion Mining Company. A sale of land has been completed by which the company will receive \$30,000 in cash and 30,000 shares in the new company, which will be known as Bullion No. 2, of which the president is Sir R. Cartwright. The new company's capital stock will be \$1,000,000 shares at \$1 each, divided as follows: 300,000 shares paid for by the shareholders of the new company, 300,000 shares to the Bullion Mining Company, 400,000 shares in the treasury to provide the necessary working capital.
