

SPEAKER OF LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, (QUEBEC), has a seat in the executive council, 63

— votes as a member only (when the voices are equal, the decision being deemed to be in the negative), 79

SPEAKER OF SENATE, to be appointed from time to time by the governor-general, from among the senators, 34

— votes as a senator only (when the voices are equal the decision being deemed to be in the negative, 36.

STEAMSHIPS, international and intercolonial lines of steamers, are under control of parliament, 92 (10, a, b.)

TAVERN LICENSES, such as are issued for provincial or municipal purposes, are under provincial control, 92 (9)

TAXATION, bills for imposing any tax must originate in the commons, 53

— or the legislative assembly, 90.

— being first recommended by the governor-general, 54

— or the lieutenant-governor, 90.

— the raising of money by any system of taxation, is under exclusive control of parliament, 91 (3).

— direct taxation within a province, for provincial purposes, is under provincial control, 92 (2).

— public property of Canada not liable to taxation, 125

TELEGRAPH LINES, such as connect two provinces, or extend beyond the limits of a province, are under control of parliament, 92 (10, a).
