FAREWELL, ABRAM. [*South Ontario.*]

Paternal grandfather emigrated from London to Am. Colonies, 1765, and was killed in Virginia, 1781, whilst fighting in the Patriot army. Father, a native of Vermont, came to Can, 1794, and settled at Whitby, where in 1803, he m. Miss Annis, the dau. of a U. E. loyalist. B. at Whitby, 21 Dec., 1812. Ed. at Common School. M., 1836, Miss Caroline Stone. A merchant and miller. Was for years a mem. of the Old "Home District" Council. An unsuccessful candidate for present seat in Can. Assembly, at g.e., 1854. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Oshawa, Ont.*
