## BILL.

An Act to repeal the Law Æde.

WHEREAS the Law *Ede*, as adopted from the Roman Law Preamble. into the Law of Lower Canada, whereby, in certain cases, the landlord or proprietor may go into possession of the house leased and evict his tenant therefrom before the expiration of the 5 term of lease, is not consistent with justice or expediency and ought to be repealed; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That the said Law *Æde* be and the same is hereby repealed, and Law *Æde* that henceforward it shall not be competent to any landlord or repealed proprietor, upon any lease hereafter to be made, to evict his 10 tenant under or by any such Law.
