BILL

To authorise the appointment of Commissioners for administering oaths to Public Accountants and to persons having claims and demands against His Majesty's Government, to facilitate the recovery of certain revenues of His Majesty, and to introduce a more regular system of accounting for the public monies than heretofore.

THEREAS it is expedient for facilitating the settlement of Public Accounts, that Commissioners should be named for administering the necessary oaths to Public Accountants, and to make further provision for the recovery of Quints, Lods et Ventes and other dues appertaining to His Majesty, and to introduce a more regular system of accounting; Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an " Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Ma-" jesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for mak-" ing more effectual provision for the Govern-" ment of the Province of Quebec, in North " America," and to make further provision for " the Government of the said Province"; and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor or person Administering the Government of the Province, for the time being, by an Instrument under his hand, to nominate and appoint in each of the Districts or Superior Districts in this Province, such person or persons as he may think fit and proper to be Commissioners for administering oaths, and for taking affidavits or affirmations of any person or persons being accountable to His Majesty's Government, for monies received for and on account of any public duty or service, or of persons having claims or demands against His Majesty's Government in this Province.
