The Student Venture Capital Program now has the capability to provide you with business start-up money to a maximum of \$1,500 per summer business venture. The loan is interest-free from April 1, 1984 to the repayment deadline of October 15, 1984.

If all loan payments are made on time, a maximum of \$250 of the loan will be reimbursed to the participant(s).

Applications are available at the Employment Development Branch of the Department of the Labour and Human Resources, Canada Employment Centres for Students, and all New Brunswick Universities and Community Colleges.
