	26-6-43		0745 hours ceiling unlimited, visibility 3 miles. haze. Flying washed in 0800 hours, washed out 1700 hours. Flying time 223.45 hours. Night flying at A.T.U. only. A picture was shown in the Station theatre at 1945 hours.	
	27-6-43		No flying in the morning because of Church parade. 1315 hours ceiling average, visibility unlimited. Flying washed in 1330 hours, washed out 1700 hours. Flying time 159.45 hours. Night flying at A.T.U. only. Two pictures were shown at the Station Theatre beginning at 1800 hours and 2000 hours. 62 airmen comprising Course 84 of the Combined Training Establishment arrived on the Station from No. 10 E.F.T.S. Pendleton, No. 12 E.F.T.S. Goderich, No. 20 E.F.T.S. Oshawa, and No. 5 E.F.T.S. High River, Alberta.
