Uplands, Ontario	January 17th 1945		(Cont'd). of Fine Music was held in the W.D. Rec. Centre, with S/L R. L. Puxley as Commentator.	
	January 18th 1945.		Cloudy to overcast. Flying washed in at 0800 hrs., washed out 1730 hrs. Flying was fit for 9½ hrs. sole. Movie was shown in the Rec. Hall, "Random Harvest", in the evening.	
	January 19th 1945		Variable sky, clear to overcast. Flying washed in at 0800 hrs., washed out at 1730 hrs. Flying was fit for 9½ hrs. sole. The usual Friday night dance was held in the Rec. Hall for airmen and airwomen, with orchestra, refreshments and prizes.	
	January 20th 1945.		Partly cloudy to overcast. Flying washed in at 0800 hrs., washed out at 1730 hrs. Flying was fit for 9½ hrs. sole. WOJ Young, Course 118, while captain of Harvard Aircraft 3204, made an emergency wheels-up landing, five miles south of Uplands, and two miles east of Hanotiek, due to engine failure at 1030 hrs. Category of crash "D-8". Pilot uninjured. Movie shown in the Rec. Hall at night, "Journey for Margaret".	
	January 21st 1945.		Cloudy to overcast. Flying washed in at 0800 hrs. Washed out at 1700 hrs. Flying was fit for 8 hrs. sole.	
	January 22nd 1945.		Overcast - intermittent snow. Flying was washed in at 0800 hrs., washed out at 1050 hrs. Washed in at 1110 hrs., washed out 1350 hrs. Flying was fit for 5½ hrs. dual. The regular Monday night Record Dance was held in the Rec. Hall.	
	January 23rd 1945.		Overcast to partly cloudy. Flying washed in 0815 hrs., washed out 1730 hrs. Flying was fit for 45 mins. dual and 8½ hrs. sole. Total flying 9 hrs. 15 mins. The most ambitious entertainment scheme ever attempted at Uplands proved most successful when an all-star boxing and wrestling show was held with Joe Louis acting as referee for some of the bouts. A capacity crowd of 4000 attended. All proceeds were given to the Fund for the welfare of Uplands' adopted Overseas Squadron. All personnel gave their services free of charge.
