

were informed that this Department had applied to the Department of the Interior to reserve for the purposes of the Industrial School at High River land shown to be so required in the sketch which accompanied Mr. Surveyor Nelson's report of the 21st July last.

There would therefore be no danger of any other claim to that section of the land being allowed by the Department of the Interior; consequently it appears to have been altogether needless for Father Lacombe to have incurred any expense in this matter.
