were informed that this Departs
ments had applied to the Department of the Interior to reserve for the furfixes of the
Ludustrial School at High River
land shown to be so required in
the sketch which accompanied
Mt Turreger Relevois report of
the 24 the July last.

There evould therefore be no danger of any other claim to that section of the land being allowed by the Department of the Interior; consequently it appears to have been allopethe needless for Father Lacombe to have incurred any expense in this matter. I have the honor to be, you but Servant.
