No. 750, Madeline Ashamock should be shown as one on the previous payroll. No. 738, Margaret Wheesk should show a total of 2 persons in the family. No. 667, Alex Goodwin is not shown in chronological order nor was it shown in the chronological order last year. No. 732 Evelyn Scott is also not shown in chronological order.

Attawapiskat Band No. 196, Xavier Rose should be shown as one man, one woman, one boy, four girls, totals seven, number paid seven. No. 248, Eddie Harry Swanson should be shown as one boy. No. 262, Xavier Hookemawillillene is shown as having been paid \$4.00 arrears, however you neglected to indicate the year for which these arrears were paid. No. 273, Jos Louis Knapaysweet should be shown as one boy. No. 275, Mary Wesley should be shown as one girl. No. 277, Xavier Wesley should be shown as one man, one woman, five boys, and no girls.
