Ottawa, 5th December, 1917.

In reply to your letter of the 28th November, I beg to say that your husband to whom you were married in 1896 was not then and has not been since acknowledged as a Treaty Indian, and consequently your application to have your children's names placed on the interest pay-list of the Fort William Band, cannot be entertained.
