Indian Reserve,

January 16, 1952

We, the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the Ahousaht Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated at Ahousaht, in the West Coast Indian Agency, in the Province of British Columbia at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 16th day of January, A.D. 1952, in the presence of the Indian Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners of the said Reserve, request that ~~amount not exceeding~~

~~sums, be paid out of money standing to the credit of this Band, for the purpose of~~ all the merchantable timber on the following Reserves of the Ahousaht Band be sold be Chetappe I.R. #17 logged off under contract Sutaquis I.R. #18 Wahous I.R. #19 (Fishery) Wahous I.R. #20 (Village)

and do hereby agree to have 50% of the profits of said sale go to the Ahousaht Band of which amount 2/3 will go to the Ahousaht Trust Account in Ottawa and 1/3 to be available for distribution to all boni-fide members of the Ahousaht Band on a per capita basis.
