

CHAPTER II.

SENTENCE MAKING.

Ex. 1. Put these words together to make sentences :—

1. see, pig, I, a, big.
2. can, see, I, cat, the, fat.
3. fat, can, the, run, cat.
4. man, a, run, can.

Ex. 2. Write these words so as to mean something :—

1. man, a, big, has, the, dog.
2. boy, red, a, cap, has, the.
3. pet, cat, a, has, Ned.
4. cup, big, has, Ann, the.

Ex. 3. Write these words so that they will form sentences :—

1. pig, has, Ben, big, a.
2. is, lot, in, the, it, now.
3. can, get, it, not, out, he.
4. Ben, in, pen, will, it, put, the.

Ex. 4. Make sentences from these words :—

1. Ben, Fred, two, are, and, boys.
2. like, fish, they, to.
3. too, like, they, them, to, eat.
4. take, fry, them, home, will, will, and, mam-
ma, they, them, their.
