OCTOBER.—Although so much has been done in the old country for the attainment of the highest results in the tillage of the soil, yet it is plain that more can be done and will be done. A paragraph in Her Majesty's speech from the Throne proroguing the Parliament in 1861 is worth noticing here. The royal commission says: "Her Majesty trusts that the Act for rendering more easy arrangements connected with the drainage of land, will assist agricultural improvements in many parts of the United Kingdom."
