And a further fum of 231, 6s. 8d. to Jared I. Chipman, for his fervices in profecuting Cri-231 6n. 8d. minals for Capital Offences at the Supreme Court at Liverpool in July Term in the laft year. J. 1. Chipman

And a further fam of 751. to Colin Campbell, Efq. of Shelburne, in truft, to be applied by 751. Collin him towards the fupport of Donald M'Kay, and his family, and to that purpole only : the Campbell faid Donald M'Kay having by an accident been deprived of the use of his hands, while employed in opening a new Roal from Shelburne to Liverpool in the last Summer : the fame to be paid out in small fums from time to time.

And a further fum of 31. 7s. 6d. to Charles Bacon, for the carriage of three directing Stones 31. 7s. 6d. for the use of the Post-Road from Halifax to Windsor, per account.

And a further fum not exceeding 500l. to His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, or 500l.
