However desirable to Canada may be the exhibition of provisions in which a member of the Cabinet like Mr. Hinks may indulge himself, when starting at the American, and however the policy which he recommends, with reference to the interests of England, may be questioned, we are thankful for any man, be it even Mr. Hinks, who evinces an inclination to relieve us from the false policy which we now occupy as purchasers in English literary works.

Our country, and not our will, restrains us from retaining the English writers to that form which the opinion of the British public can afford.

Few men in the Colony, apart from the officials, are in the enjoyment of incomes which enable them to indulge in those expensive luxuries which the acquisition of London editions of popular works entails; hence the British masses are excluded from the streams of intellectual nourishment so copiously poured forth from the metropolitan fountain, and only enjoy them by the translations of our laws, and smuggling the intellectual works across the frontier.

Conducts between inclination and duty, are unfavorable to the morality of society, and the results, thus far experienced, have sufficed to prove the insufficiency of a legislation which, while it cannot lightly be blamed, is yet inconsistent with the intellectual progress of the country. It will be difficult to reconcile the conflicting interests, without entailing injury upon the latter.

It is the duty of the Canadian public, or the British author, who writes in English, to copy the original, and not our will, restrains us from retaining the English writers to that form which the opinion of the British public can afford.

Few men in the Colony, apart from the officials, are in the enjoyment of incomes which enable them to indulge in those expensive luxuries which the acquisition of London editions of popular works entails; hence
