PRODUCTION. It is scarcely necessary to say that the production of milk is the greatest function of the dairy cow. The economical production of large quantities of milk, butter and cheese, determines the value of the cow, and the best efforts of breeders of dairy stock should always be directed towards this goal. If the dairy cow does not yield a profitable flow of milk, she ceases to have any reason for existence. Beefing qualities are of comparatively little importance, except in cases when a good cow loses the use of a portion of her udder, or in
