Post Office notice—Registratio of Letters.

On and after the 1st April next, Letters may be registered in Newfoundland by the payment by a fee of 6d. currency on Local Letters, and 6d. sterling on Letters for the United Kingdomand for British Colonies, not passing through the United Kingdom, a further fee will be charg ed on Letters forwarded through the United Kingdom.

The safe delivery of those Letters, will not be guaranteed by the Post Office; yet their inland transmission will be comparatively secure, from the means that will be adopted to trace them to their destination.

The postage on Registered letters must be paid in advance.

Full information respecting the Registration of Letters may be obtained on application a the General Post Office, or Post Offices in the extern districts.

Heads A moderate berth, you will clear the B randies. Rocks by steering for Green Island Light. Green Is land is situated in lat. 48. 30 M. 19ng. 53,03 West.
