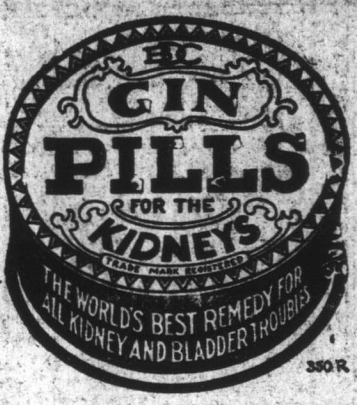

From sources close to the throne has come the announcement that her youngest daughter, Sleana, commonly called 'Minon', due to her extreme beauty, is about to become affianced to Humbert, Crown Prince of Italy, nicknamed the 'Modern Apollo'. The marriage is declared to be a royal love match. Humbert is 19 years old and the princess but 17. The marriage will complete Queen Marie's ambitious scheme for royal hegemony of the Balkans. Her daughter, Elizabeth, married the Crown Prince of Greece. A second daughter has just become engaged to the King of Serbia. Crown Prince Carol of Roumania is the husband of a daughter of King Constantine of Greece. Carol is Marie's oldest son. A second son, Prince Nicholas, is reported on the eve of becoming engaged to the daughter of the former Czar Ferdinand of Bulgaria.

Evelyn Nesbitt Thaw Has Disappeared.

Evelyn Nesbitt Thaw has vanished as suddenly as she rose to notoriety through the slaying of Stanford White by her one-time husband, Harry K. Thaw. A month ago she was evicted from her tea room and apartment in New York. Lee and Jake Shubert, her landlords, had her few shabby effects placed on the sidewalk by a city marshal. The eviction was but one of a series of tragedies that have entered the life of the former belle of Broadway in the last few months. Some time before she had taken a huge overdose of morphine in an effort to die. The suicidal attempt came when eviction threatened. The city marshal was waiting to dispossess her. The resultant publicity caused her landlords to allow her to stay in her tea room and apartment a little longer. But a month ago the blow fell. She was evicted. Without funds, and evidently without friends, she found herself alone on the sidewalk beside her meagre belongings—a trunk and a small handbag. Next she found a little furnished bedroom at Broadway and 52nd street. A week later, just three weeks ago, she dropped from sight. Since then no one has been found who has seen her. Those who know Evelyn are expressing the fear that she may have sought death again and found it.
