

LOCAL MARKET.

London, Wednesday, Oct. 16.
There were 15 loads of hay offered today; only one load selling at the highest price. One load of straw sold at \$7.50 per ton. Oats went higher, selling at \$1.69 to \$1.73 per cwt, which is 57¢ to 58¢ 4-5c per bu.

WEEKLY REVIEW.

The markets held here were characterized by brisk trading in every department. Prices were firm in nearly every line, especially for hay and oats. Grain—Oats were consistently higher than last week's quotations; sales are made at \$1.69 to \$1.73 per cwt. Wheat is firmer, sales being made in every case at \$1 per bu; there are not many loads coming in at present. Barley is a scarce commodity on this market, but the local brewers hope they will be compelled to bid in the Manitoba markets, as they can neither secure quantity nor quality in Ontario. Hay and straw—The demand for hay has not slackened, and prices are higher. Dealers feel that prices are advancing, and the buyers and the dealers in baled hay are still of the opinion that prices are at the top. They say that there is more hay in the country than most people are aware of, and that the farmers are not anything this winter but cordwood, in order to save the hay for the market, the buyers say that they would not be so priced to see hay next spring considerably lower in price than at the present time. Straw is very scarce and prices are higher at \$7.50 per ton, with the prospect that prices will again advance.

Butter and Eggs—Butter is scarce and the prospects are that prices will hold firm for some time as the stocks are small; sales are made at 25¢ for crocks and 26¢ for pails in wholesale lots. The fine weather has caused not a few little sales for eggs; sales are made at 25¢ for store lots and 24¢ to 25¢ for basket lots.

Poultry—It seems that the farmers are endeavoring to sell anything that requires feeding, owing to the high prices of the supply of poultry is larger than usual at this time of the year; prices are lower, sales being made at 12¢ to 13¢ per lb for live chickens, and 8¢ to 9¢ dressed; old hens are a drug, at 10¢ to 11¢ alive and 6¢ to 7¢ dressed; ducks, 10¢ to 11¢ alive and 6¢ to 7¢ dressed; turkeys, 10¢ to 11¢ alive and 6¢ to 7¢ dressed.

Pigs—The price of feed has had an effect on the demand for small pigs, and prices are about one-half that paid a month ago; most of those offered are Saturday sold at \$1 each; \$2 each was considered a high price. Dressed hogs—the demand is fair, but it will be better when the weather is colder; sales are made at 18¢ to 19¢ per cwt, the latter price for hogs which weigh about 150 to 160 lbs.

Butcher's Meats—Best beef sold at 85¢ to 86¢ per cwt; veal, 85¢ to 86¢; lamb, 11¢ to 12¢ per lb.
