"Life a Perfect Burden" MANY LIVES LOST IN HESTIA WRECK.

Steamer Runs on Rocky Ledges Near Grand Manan Early Monday Morning.
FOUR BOY PASSENGERS

Despatches from Eastport confirm in detail the loss of the Donaldson Line steamer, Hestia, and record the loss of 24 of the forty persons on board. The Associated Press despatch contains the following particulars:

Eastport, Me., Oct. 25.—Steamship Hestia was wrecked on Monday morning on a shoal inside of Old Provincetown Ledge, off Seal Cove, Grand Manan. Four of the victims were young Scotch lads, who were passengers on the ill-fated steamer, and the others were members of the steaming crew. Captain Newman and twenty or more members of the crew were last seen yesterday morning in a ship's boat in the turbulent waters and treacherous ledges of the Bay of Fundy. Of the forty persons who were aboard the steamer when she slipped on the shoal at 1 a. m. Monday, only six are positively known to have been saved. They were forced to stick to their impaled craft, clinging to every available means of support while the steamer was tossed by the sea.

It was not until 3 p. m. to-day that life savers from the Seal Cove station were able to reach the stranded steamer. When rescued, the men were in a weakened state after their fourteen hours ordeal. Those known to be saved are: Third Mate Stewart, Second Engineer Morgan, Seaman Keen, McKenzie, Smith and McVicker.

A heavy northeasterly gale is believed to have been responsible for the Hestia's fate. The sailors on the middle watch had been out of their hammocks an hour, and all the other watches were on deck for the night. The vessel's nose became impaled on the rocks, and the stern was left in the surrounding sea. Those on watch had to be rescued by the crew, and the other officers of the crew, including the captain, were rescued by the crew.
