Deadweight of Barbed Wire.

A reaction has set in against the barbed wire fence in the United States, the manufacture of which has grown to be a great industry. The reason of the reaction is the discovery by the farmers that in substituting the wire for the old-fashioned fences and hedges they have driven away the insect and bird life which used to eat up the worms and similar pests so destructive of the farmer's crops. These birds need the shelter and cover of the hedges which formerly separated the tilled fields. Even if the fence was of wood it would grow up with the weeds and brush, and the birds would find a refuge in it.
