Chronic Bronchitis. Chronic Bronchitis is inflammation of the mucous membrane of the bronchial tubes, and is one of the most common of the pulmonary affections. Chronic Bronchitis more often occurs later in life. When a cold settles on the lungs, the disease either ends in bronchitis or pneumonia. If it ends in bronchitis, it usually passes off as a cold on the chest, and still the patient does not feel entirely well. He feels tired and languid, and is incapable of taking his usual amount of exercise, and experiences a shortness of breath, with more or less coughing, which is accompanied by an expectation of phlegm, followed by a hectic flush, and loss of strength, and night sweats continue, when the patient usually succumbs to the disease. This is simply catarrh of the larger bronchus.

Chronic Bronchitis. In the later stages of the disease the mucous membrane of the larger bronchial tube reforms, while in the smaller tubes and air cells of the lungs the mucous membrane becomes congested and inflamed. There are no cavities nor tubercles in the lungs, but merely a watery accumulation of the bronchial tubes and air cells of the lungs. The patient dies from exhaustion and suffocation, being unable to expectorate the mucus which accumulates in the passage leading to the lungs, which in some cases is sticky and small in quantity, but more commonly copious, of a light straw or yellowish appearance. Oftentimes streaks of blood make their appearance in the mucus, and at times there is a considerable amount of blood in the mucus, which is liable to take a cold at which time the mucus becomes clear and frothy, and it is not uncommonly the case that the patient dies in one of these attacks.
