

Cultural Promotion: Visits of Foreign Cultural Personalities to Canada

Visiting Foreign Artists Invited by Canadian Cultural Institutions

The program, administered on behalf of the Department by the Arts Awards Service of the Canada Council, offers financial assistance to Canadian cultural organizations and institutions to support visits of distinguished foreign artists to teach the creative or performing arts. Visitors are expected to supplement the activities of the host organization rather than act as a replacement, therefore applications to fill a post that is temporarily vacant cannot be considered.

The value of assistance is up to \$1,000 a month stipend. Return airfare at economy rates (22-45 day excursion fare, if applicable) is assured.

Tenure is from two weeks to four months.

The Department invites foreign critics, arts' journalists, cultural personalities and impresarios to visit Canada for short familiarization tours.

With the assistance of federal and provincial agencies and cultural associations, the Department also establishes itineraries for the visitors.

Projects submitted to the Department under the above two programs are studied by its Advisory Committee on Foreign Cultural Relations.
