- We have counselled and worked closely with Con air in preparation of its offer to be submitted in July
- Conair proposal under evaluation but IBAMA (en vironment agency) more interested in CL-215.
- Purchase of CL-215 remains difficult due to bu dgetary constraints.
- 1. Lider will likely purchase one Challenger air craft in first half of 1990.
- -While contract negotiations with Sarney government did not proceed due to lack of funding, prospects with Collor government are more encouraging.
