GUIDELINES TO BE OBSERVED BY PUBLIC
SERVANTS CONCERNING CONFLICT OF INTEREST
SITUATIONS

SHORT TITLE

1. These guidelines may be cited as the Public Servants Conflict of Interest Guidelines.

GUIDELINES

2. It is by no means sufficient for a person in a position of responsibility in the public service to act within the law. There is an obligation not simply to obey the law but to act in a manner so scrupulous that it will bear the closest public scrutiny. In order that honesty and impartiality may be beyond doubt, public servants should not place themselves in a position where they are under obligation to any person who might benefit from special consideration or favour on their part or seek in any way to gain special
