

Transmitted Information, or anything incorporating Transmitted Information, to any third party, including any third country government, any national of a third country, or any contractor, organization or other entity other than the Parties, without the prior written consent of the originating Party or unless such disclosure, release or access is otherwise in accordance with the provisions of another agreement or arrangement between the Parties;

- (d) the receiving Party shall comply with any additional limitations on the use, disclosure, release and access to Transmitted Information which may be specified by, or on behalf of, the originating Party;
- (e) the receiving Party shall not downgrade the security classification of Classified Information or the level of Designated Information without the prior written consent of the originating Party;
- (f) the originating Party shall inform the receiving Party of any change in the classification or designation level of Transmitted Information;
- (g) the receiving Party shall take all steps legally available to it to keep Transmitted Information free from disclosure under any legislative provision; and
- (h) each Party shall maintain accountability and control procedures to manage the dissemination of, and access to, Transmitted Information.

2. When Transmitted Information is no longer required for the purpose for which it was provided the receiving Party shall:

- (a) return the Transmitted Information to the originating Party; or
- (b) destroy the Transmitted Information in accordance with procedures of the receiving Party for the destruction of Classified or Designated Information, as appropriate.

3. The Parties may mutually determine such additional requirements for the protection of Transmitted Information as they consider appropriate for the purpose of facilitating the exchange and protection of such Information.

Article 6 Access

Access to Transmitted Information shall be limited to those personnel of a Party who:

- (a) are nationals of either of the Parties, unless the originating Party has given its prior written consent otherwise;
