FIELD CROP RULES AND PRIZE LIST

Competitions Under Auspices of Ontario Vegetable Growers.

The rules and regulations just drawn up by the Ontario Vegetable Growers' Association for their field-crop competition are as follows:

There are to be four classes, viz., tomatoes, celery and early potatoes. Members of the branches in each district will compete among themselves for the field-crop prizes offered in their particular districts.

In these competitions the province is divided into five districts as follows: District No. 1—Cyrville, Ottawa, Kingston, Simcoe and Welland.

District No. 2—Belleville, Brantford, Simcoe and Toronto.

District No. 3—Aylmer, London, St. Thomas and Stratford.

District No. 4—Blackwell, Ojibway, Canard River, Sarnia and Tecumseh.

District No. 5—Dunnville, St. Catharines and Welland.

Judges will be provided free of all charge by the Ontario Department of Agriculture. Secretaries of branches are requested to enter the competitions must notify J. Lockie Wilson, secretary-treasurer and managing director of the Ontario Vegetable Growers' Association, Parliament Buildings, Toronto.

It is necessary that the secretary of each branch notify the secretary of the Central Association at least one week before the crops are ready to be judged.

The prizes offered in each district for each of the four classes are: First, \$10; second, \$5; third, \$2.50; fourth, \$1.00.

As the number of entries from each district is limited the members are recommended to act promptly.



Last week a petition was presented to the mayor, asking the board of control to recommend to the council the annexation of the district north of Danforth avenue. The Board for approval or otherwise, as the majority of ratepayers are found for or against. The territory is defined in the petition as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of Mount Pleasant Cemetery, down Bayview to St. Clair, east along St. Clair to the intersection of the C.N.R., along the C.N.R. to East Don Junction, then along the Montreal branch road to the York and Scarborough town line, south on the town line to the city limits—about 2000 acres.
