ST. LAWRENCE MARKET.

There were 18 loads of hay on the St. Lawrence Market yesterday, which remained steady in price.

There were also five loads of oats, which Phillips of Coffee & Co. states sold at 66c to 68c per bushel.

Potatoes were slightly easier in price than they were last week, bringing \$1.30 per bag; wholesale car lots, \$1.15 to \$1.20 per bag.

Spring chickens are selling at from 22c to 25c per lb. retail. Ducklings are not in much demand; they sell at 18c to 20c per lb. retail.

Choice dairy butter is bringing 22c to 23c per lb. retail, and the creamery 22c to 25c per lb.

Farm Produce, Retail. Wheat, fall, bushel, \$1.10 to \$1.12. Barley, bushel, 90c to 1.00.

Hay, new, per ton, 20.00 to 21.00. Hay, mixed, per ton, 17.00 to 18.00. Straw, cattle, per ton, 17.00 to 18.00.

Butcher's Cattle. Receipts moderate and values practically unchanged. Choice veal calves \$10 to \$10.50.

Stocks and Feeder. Deliveries moderate and demand fair. Prices were about steady on a slow market.

FAT CATTLE TRADE CONTINUES DULL

Some Commission Agents Unable to Clear Costs on Much Stock.

HOG VALUES FIRMER

Buyers Complain of Unfinished Quality of Most of Cattle Offerings.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Yards on Thursday were 35 carloads, comprising 323 cattle, 1139 hogs, 648 sheep and lambs, and 55 calves.

The light delivery of calves caused prices to remain steady. The market for sheep and lambs was easier, especially for lambs.

Deliveries of hogs were light and prices were again firmer, as will be seen by sales given.
