A Question as to Promissory Note Made and Payable in the United States - A Warning to Creditors.

A Warning to Administrators.
A Court of Appeal, composed of the Chancellor and Justices Ferguson and Meredith, has given judgment in Irwin v. Toronto General Trusts Company on plaintiff's appeal from judgment of Justice Rose, dismissing the action. The court holds that an administrator has no power to convey a portion of an estate's real estate to his widow for a release of her dower, and of a claim by her against the estate. The land should be sold and a sum in gross paid the widow, or the income on a portion paid her. The appeal is allowed, with costs, and action dismissed with costs.

ARMOUR CORNERS WHEAT.

The Great Best Man of Chicago Expects to Make a Pile.
New York, June 25.—Philip D. Armour, chief magnate of the Chicago beef trust, is credited by operators in the wheat market here with having cornered the July wheat market. There are less than 20,000,000 bushels of July wheat in the United States. The Chicago millions of this in Minnesota out of the market for grinding. Some Apprehension of a Squeeze in This Option.

LIVERPOOL MARKET FIRMER

The Local Stock Market Active With Cable Bonds Higher.

Another Advance in Canadian Produce

Chicago is lower in Liverpool. Liverpool wheat futures bid to bid higher. Cash wheat in Chicago 1/2c higher at 72c.

Receipts of grain at Chicago to-day: Wheat 10,000,000 bushels, oats 1,000,000 bushels, corn 500,000 bushels.

Receipts of wheat at Liverpool the past three days were 10,000,000 bushels, including 5,000,000 bushels of American. Corn same time 120,000,000 bushels.

Receipts of hogs at Chicago to-day, 20,000, or 2000 more than expected; official Thursday, 24,315, less than expected. Estimated for Saturday, 20,000. Market active and 2 1/2c to 3c for heavy shippers, 2 1/2c to 3 1/2c.

Cattle receipts at Chicago to-day, 2000; market quiet and steady.

Exports at New York to-day: Flour, 9616 barrels and 2241 sacks; wheat, 61,404 bushels. There are all sorts of rumors about as to what the July long in Chicago wheat are trying to do. It is generally supposed that the market is to be an impression that Armour was trying to help him stand for delivery, and as stocks in Chicago are steady at 2 1/2c per bushel, and in car lot at 1 1/2c to 1 3/4c per bushel, the position of the shorts is by no means pleasant. The poor prospects for the receipts the next 30 days are also against the short sellers, and while it is difficult to get at how much shortage there is left in July, there is no doubt that it is difficult to keep the trade on the ragged edge until the end of the month, without affecting prices either way.
