Meagher was removed to the hospital opposite the Woodbine club house and Dr. Elliott and Rowan declared that there was practically no hope of recovery.

The unfortunate horseman was buried early this morning. He was a son of Mr. Thomas Meagher of the Imperial Hotel, Jarvis street, and was about 24 years of age.
