

### IN THE DAY OF PERIL

The proposals of the American Con-ss as to the reprisals which the nited States might take against Great itain and her allies because of interence with the free play of American de during the war, have caused the ew York Outlook to speak out strongty. It is not pleased with the way congress passed over the loss of American lives at Germany's hands, but at once talks of reprisals when there is loss of business at Britain's hands. "It is not strange," it says, "that satirists abroad think we care more for property than

for life."

The trouble has been, in the opinion of the Outlook, that Washington has taken too much the view of the attorney who would regard the nation as his client and seek only to defend her legal rights, whereas the view taken should have been that of the statesman concerned for the nation's welfare. "The official policy of the American nation," it says, "has been that of an attorney, not that of a statesman, and is full of serious peril to the nation in the future." 


