CAMPBELL ISLAND
FOE TO HAY FEVER
Haven of Rest for Afflicted, Victims of Disease Declare.
New York, Aug. 19.—Campbell Island, New Brunswick, is the most favorable spot that has yet been discovered on the American continent for the victim of hay fever. This is stated in an announcement made by the United States Hay Fever Association, as the result of investigation by members of that organization.
Statistics compiled by the association indicate the degree of immunity experienced by members at various summer resorts. Campbell Island is awarded as highest rating, and is recommended as a comfortable vacation place for those afflicted with hay fever.
Forty-eight members of the association visited Campbell, and all were immune while there. Sixteen visited Montreal. Three were immune, six partially immune, and seven went right on sneezing.
A TRAVELING CLINIC.
Halifax Chronicle—Arrangements are now almost completed for the placing of a Red Cross mobile clinic in Lunenburg county, similar to the one which has carried on such excellent work in the colonies of Antigonish and Guysboro. The clinic will spend one month in Lunenburg and will endeavor to reach those districts where medical and dental service is not easily available. The medical sections of the clinic will deal only with tuberculosis and will be in charge of a well known tuberculosis expert. The clinic will begin its tour on Tuesday, August 22.
