BORN IN NEW YORK, IS HELD AS ALIEN

Woman Ordered Deported as Wife of British Guiana Man.

New York, March 17.—Argument was heard by Federal Judge Bondy on a writ of habeas corpus obtained in behalf of Mrs. Gertrude Gomes, a native of Brooklyn, who became an alien by marrying a native of British Guiana and who has been refused admission to this country on the ground that she is an insane alien.
