- Q.367 How fast would you say the driver was travelling that night?

- A.372 When I told him he was - I thought he was pretty close to to the ditch and he hauled it over a little to quick.
- Q.372 What happened then?
- A.372 That is when he upset.
- Q.373 If you had not spoken to the driver of the vehicle and the vehicle had kept on in the direction which it was driving in would it have gone into the ditch on the left hand side?
- A.373 Yes, Sir, it would have.
- Q.374 How far did the car travel before it upset - after it went on the shoulder of the road?
- A.374 Oh! I would say about 20 feet, Sir, 20 feet.
- Q.375 20 feet?
- A.375 That is right, Sir.
