- Q. Then he lived with you and your sister? A. Yes.
- Q. After he left the lot and while he was living with you and your sister who was on the lot?
- A. Thomas Sutherland.
- Q. Just as soon as you took your father to live with you Thomas Sutherland was on the lot?
- A. Not right away.

Commissioner-

- Q. While your father was alive did he go into possession?
- A. Not till after he died.
- Q. You don't know whether Thomas Sutherland was in possession when your father died, or not?
- A. He was not there when my father died.
- Q. You have said that he was and now you say that he was not?

MRS. E . MARGARET CANAVAN: sworn;-

Mr. Clarke-

- Q. How long after your father left this lot, lot 2 was it that Thomas Sutherland came to live on it?
- A. About a year and a half.
- Q. Where was your father at that time.
- A. He was living with me.
- Q. Andwhen did he die? A. He was dead.
- Q. He was dead at the time that Thomas Sutherland went to live on the lot? A. Yes.
- Q. How long had he been dead when Thomas Sutherland went to live on the lot?
- A. About a year.

- Q. How did Thomas Sutherland come to go on the lot?
- A. I will tell you the whole thing. When my mother died my father had quite a lot of property, that is he had cattle, he had two stables and a store house and a little dwelling
